2. Candidates in service other than Magadh University, Bodhgaya Service are required to submit their application through proper channel with NOC from his/her present employer. The candidates however, can submit their application in advance without NOC, in anticipation of grant of NOC from their employer. But they must produce NOC at the time of interview.
3. Duly filled application form alongwith Bank Draft, Attested Copies of relevant marks sheet/ certificate/ testimonials must be submitted latest by the 01-03-2011 through registered post only to the Registrar, Magadh University, Bodhgaya.

In the light of the order given by Hon'ble Patna High Court in the CWJC No. 17804 of 2009, CWJC No. 17993 of 2009 and CWJC No. 5730 of 2010, applications are invited from eligible candidates as well as those Principals who have been affected by this order of Hon'ble Patna High Court for the Post of Principals under Magadh University Service in the prescribed format. The application must be accompanied with a crossed DD of Rs. 2000/- (for S.C./S.T. Rs. 1000/-) only in favour of Registrar, Magadh University, Bodh Gaya payable at Bodh Gaya.

Application must reach to the office of the Registrar, Magadh University, Bodh Gaya on or before 01.03.2011 by registered post only.

1. The panel prepared by the selection committee will be valid for one year from the date of publication of the panel.
2. Vacancies which may accrue during the period of the validity of the panel may be filled up from the panel of respective category.
3. In view of directive of the Hon'ble High Court, Patna after preparing the panel of general category candidates from combined merit list, separate panel of reserved category candidates, as per the reservation policy of the

Government, by applying the roaster to the 44 posts of principals of the 44 constituent colleges of the University, shall also be prepared and finalized, even though the vacancies of particular category may not have already become available on the date of advertisement.

4. The article shall be accepted only from those referred journals which are conceived to be standard journal with specific registration in view of the selection committee.

Note :-

- (i) If a candidates has M.Phil. as well as Ph.D., he/she shall be given the marks allotted to Ph.D. degree only.
